

TESTICULAR ULTRASOUND

OVERVIEW: The sonographer examines the right and left testicles, and the right and left epididymis with and without Doppler.

PREPARATION: No special preparation required for a testicular ultrasound

This test can rule out and diagnose a number of problems such as (not limited to):

- Testicular torsion
- Identify masses or cysts within testicle/epididymis
- Determine if a mass is solid or cystic
- Determine the cause of testicular swelling

The reason for the test will depend on your symptoms.

THIS ULTRASOUND WILL TAKE ABOUT 20-30 MINUTES AND THE REPORT WILL BE BACK TO YOUR ORDERING PHYSICIAN WITHIN 24-48 HOURS.
