Charcot Foot: The History

Jean Marie Charcot was a prominent neurologist in France in the late 1800s. He worked in a charity hospital called the Salpêtrière Hospital, which he described as a "museum of human suffering". Charcot Arthropathy is a condition of the foot that weakens the bones. Eventually the foot bones will fracture and the foot will change shape. Dr. Charcot was the first to document cases of this debilitating disease.

The Symptoms:

I had two referral patients come to see me this month with Charcot Arthropathy. The first was from an urgent care facility and the second was from a primary care doctor. Both of these fairly active patients had long-term diabetes, and both were referred to me for treatment of Cellulitis, which is a bacterial foot infection. Each of the patients experienced redness and swelling in one of their feet. Neither patient had any open wounds or entry points. In both cases, the patient's blood sugar had remained normal and no systemic signs of infection were present.

The Challenge:

Charcot Foot symptoms greatly resemble those of an infection, so it's easy to misdiagnose Charcot as an infection and prescribe antibiotics. That is exactly what happened with both of these patients. The original physician in each case diagnosed the condition as a diabetic foot infection. They were given antibiotics and then referred to me.



Advice:

Early detection is **key**. If you have a diabetic foot that presents itself with swelling, redness and warmth with no apparent cause such as an open sore, you may have Charcot Foot. Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) is No Joke!


Symptoms

- Cramping in feet, calves, or thighs
