

What is a Chronic Urinary Tract Infection?

- A chronic urinary tract infection (UTI) is a urinary infection that doesn't respond to proper treatment or continues to recur after being treated.
- Women are more likely to have chronic UTIs because of the location of their urethra in relation to the rectum and because women have a shorter urethra than men. This makes it easier for bacteria to reach the bladder and multiply.



The MonaLisa Touch delivers gentle laser energy to the vaginal wall tissue. It stimulates a healing response and enhanced moisture and decreased laxity in the vaginal canal. A typical course of treatment is three procedures over 12 weeks.

Question & Answer

Q: What happens during treatment?

A: The procedure will seem similar to your annual exam, and will likely be even quicker. Your healthcare provider will insert the laser into your vagina and deliver laser energy "pulses." The total procedure time is less than 5 minutes.



Q: Does it hurt?

A: The laser energy itself is virtually painless. Some patients report mild discomfort with the laser tip insertion during the first procedure due to vaginal dryness.

Q: How many treatments are required?

A: To obtain optimal results we recommend 3 treatments each 6 weeks apart.

Q: How soon can I expect results?
