

Post-Treatment Instructions for Tattoo Removal

1. On completion of a tattoo removal treatment, patients may experience minor discomfort and redness. This discomfort will subside quickly. However, the redness will last for 24-48 hours. Once the redness is gone, the treated area will look similar to the way it did prior to treatment. Pin point bleeding may also occur.
2. Patients may wash the treated area as normal.
3. It is recommended that the treated area be covered with an antibiotic ointment for 1-week.
4. The body will absorb the broken up ink and the area should be retreated every 9-weeks.
5. Multiple treatments may be required to achieve the desired result.
