

Post-Treatment Instructions for Tattoo Removal

- 1. On completion of a tattoo removal treatment, patients may experience minor discomfort and redness. This discomfort will subside quickly. However, the redness will last for 24-48 hours. Once the redness is gone, the treated area will look similar to the way it did prior to treatment. Pin point bleeding may also occur.
- 2. Patients may wash the treated area as normal.
- 3. It is recommended that the treated area be coved with an antibiotic ointment for 1-week.
- 4. The body will absorb the broken up ink and the area should be retreated every 9-weeks.
- 5. Multiple treatments may be required to achieve the desired result.
