

Concerned about Coronavirus?

Guirguis Obstetrics and Gynecology would like to update you regarding the recent coronavirus (COVID-19) situation we all face. Please know that your safety is our top-priority.

There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus. The virus is believed to spread through person-to-person transmission when an infected individual who is in close contact with another (within about 6 feet), produces respiratory droplets by coughing or sneezing. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.

Take steps to protect yourself:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

You can be assured that at all times we have practiced universal precautions based on CDC guidelines. This includes (but is not limited to):

- Wiping down and disinfecting common areas, exam rooms, medical equipment and frequently shared items.
- Canceling group healthcare activities

Please <u>notify us if you are sick prior to your arrival</u> and we will reschedule your appointment. Please limit (or avoid) bringing visitors/children with you to appointments.

We are currently exploring non-traditional alternatives to face-to-face visits and triages. We appreciate your patience with us as we explore the implementations of these systems.
