As all of you know we are in the middle of a national crisis with Covid-19. The Connecticut Department of Public Health, along with many other federal agencies, has asked providers to avoid seeing non-urgent patients in the office. At Colon and Rectal Surgeons of Greater Hartford, we are following state and federal guidelines but we also want to help ensure that our patients continue to get care during this trying and unprecedented time.

At this time, we will be seeing patients in our Bloomfield office only and we are limiting patients coming into the office. We will be seeing patients with urgent needs as well as colon, rectal and anal cancer in an attempt to not delay treatment during this time.

Please keep in mind that if you have any of the following symptoms do not visit the office – fever, cough, runny nose, chills, sore throat or body aches. We are actively trying to enact telemedicine capabilities and will update you as soon as possible.

In addition we will not be accepting online booking until further notice, but please call the office to book an appointment if needed (860-242-8591). If you have any questions about if you should be seen in the office or not, do not hesitate to call. We have both staff and physicians available every day to help answer and triage your questions and concerns.

Finally, we are also canceling any elective surgeries and procedures as this is in the best interest of our patients – if you are scheduled for surgery in the coming weeks you will hear from your provider soon. We understand that this is incredibly frustrating but our goals are to provide the safest care to our patients.

We appreciate your understanding and we will continue to work through this trying time together as a community.
