That's why we have taken steps to help you achieve your family-building dreams while minimizing your risk of exposure. At this time, we are offering testing and treatment cycles to patients who decide they wish to resume attempts at conception and who give their full consent to do so in the current climate. We encourage you to schedule a telemedicine visit to review your options and plan your cycle. For those not yet ready to continue treatment, we also encourage a telemedicine consultation to discuss your specific situation and devise a plan to help you build your family as quickly and safely as possible.

Our experienced and compassionate physicians are available to see new as well as existing patients. We also offer free second opinion consultations for patients already evaluated and possibly treated at an outside fertility clinic.

University Reproductive Associates currently offers:

- New and follow-up patients consultations via telemedicine
- All laboratory services including sperm testing, hormone blood tests, genetic testing of embryos, etc.
- Minimally invasive surgery.
- Artificial insemination, in-vitro fertilization, fresh and frozen embryo transfers, donor sperm and egg cycles.

Also, following the recommendations of the CDC, International Fertility Societies and guidance from the New Jersey State Department of health, we are following these procedures to reduce the risk of exposure and transmission of Covid-19.

1. Only scheduled patients should come during morning monitoring or for sperm testing. No partners should accompany them, please wait in the car or outside the office.
2. Patients and staff who are sick or who have reason to believe they may have been in close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19, are asked to stay home and not come into the office. This is true even for patients in treatment cycles.
3. Each exam/procedure room is undergoing a more intensive cleaning between each patient.
4. Some other precautions we are taking to ensure the health and well being of all is to screen all new and existing patients coming in the office. Patients will be asked a series of questions when entering the office (I.E, if they are experiencing any flu like symptoms, body aches, coughing, etc.)

5. Patients will be asked to sanitize their hands before entering any exam room.

6. Please be aware that our entire office will continue to be cleaned and sanitized thoroughly throughout the day as always.
