PLEASE REVIEW THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PROSTATE BIOPSY

- You have been given a prescription for an antibiotic.
- Start antibiotic in the morning, the day before your biopsy.
- Continue taking the antibiotics every morning until finished.
- Give yourself a FLEET enema three hours before your scheduled biopsy. (The enema can be purchased at any pharmacy, no prescription needed).
- NO aspirin or products containing aspirin or ibuprofen for one week prior to the procedure, and three days after the procedure.
- If you are taking any type of blood thinner medication, such as Coumadin or Plavix, STOP this medication one week prior to procedure.
- Try not to empty your bladder for 2 hours before your procedure, since the doctor will want you to urinate following the biopsy.

If you must cancel the procedure appointment, please advise our office within 24 hours. Otherwise you will be charged a \$25.00 set up fee.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR AFTER YOUR PROSTATE BIOPSY

- You should drink plenty of fluids following your biopsy.
- You could have some discomfort or pain in the rectal area for up to 24 hours.
- You might also have following after biopsy:
 - Blood in your stools or blood clots
 - Blood in urine
 - Blood in semen
 - Symptoms may occur up to several weeks after biopsy. If you have persistent bleeding or fever and chills, please do not hesitate to call our office.
