CARE FOLLOWING VENEER PLACEMENT

Mild discomfort: Mild soreness and tenderness particularly at the injection-site(s) is not uncommon. Take whatever medication you would use to treat a mild headache.

Discoloration of the provisional veneers: Temporary veneers are tooth colored and translucent. Occasionally, a few days following placement, a dark stain might migrate beneath the temporary coverage beginning at the gumline. This unsightly cosmetic problem can easily be removed by Dr. Nealis and will not jeopardize the health of the tooth. In the event that this happens contact the office to arrange a brief visit.

Maintain good oral hygiene with the provisional veneers: Continue with good oral home care. Brush and floss daily. Remember to let go of one end of the floss and pull it through. Do not pop it out. You could pop off the provisional veneer if you don't follow these instructions.

If the provisional veneer comes off: Call our office and we will arrange an immediate time to have it replaced.
