Explanation of Contact Lens Professional Fees

To Our Contact Lens Wearing Patients,

Please note that contact lens professional fees billed under procedure code 92310 are not included in the service provided in a comprehensive eye examination and refraction.

Contact lens professional fees are billed to the patient and are not typically paid by health insurance, with the exception of certain vision plans.

QUEST and Medicaid never covers contact lens professional fees.

These fees are incurred when a patient is:

- Fitted with contact lenses for the first time
- A new contact lens patient is evaluated for the first time
- When an established patient presents for reevaluation of their contact lens fit in conjunction with their annual eye examination in order to receive an up to date contact lens prescription
- When an established patient desires to change to a different contact lens type

The charge for an initial fitting is \$78.53.

The contact lens evaluation fee is \$52.36.

Contact lens materials are charged for over and above the professional evaluation and fitting fees. The charge for the supply of contact lenses varies depending on the brand and type of lens decided upon at the time of the evaluation.
