Dear Advanced OBGYN Patient:

The last couple of months have been challenging for all of us. During the pandemic AOG has continued to see in-office patients for urgent gynecologic issues, or obstetrical care in a controlled and safe manner. As the Covid-19 outbreak subsides and Federal and State restrictions are lifted, we will return to providing wellness and routine visits in the office. On May 26, 2020 all 4 offices will be open. We will continue to provide online virtual visits when appropriate or feasible.

As always, your safety, comfort and well-being are our focus. Here is how we will re-establish your access to care with the utmost safety:

- High-level employee protocols that include hand sanitation before and after every interaction, appropriate PPE, daily employee symptom tracking log, and temperature testing.
- Meticulous cleaning and sanitizing of all surfaces, patient areas, and equipment.
- Stringent social distancing measures that expedite the check-in process or use properly spaced waiting room chairs.
- Spacing out appointment times to prevent crowded waiting areas.
- Screening of all patients for fever and respiratory symptoms on arrival.
- Restricting visitors/companions from the office in order to reduce potential exposure to others. Only individuals accompanying patients who require assistance will be permitted to remain with the patient.
- Virtual visits are preferred for adult respiratory patients in order to make an assessment without exposure. If an in-person visit or COVID-19 testing is needed, patients will be assisted accordingly.
- **Patients are required to wear a face mask - please come to the office wearing one.** If you are unable to obtain a mask, we will provide you one and a member of our team will assist you.
