## Refraction Service and Fee

- A refraction is the process of determining your best corrected vision and if there is a need for corrective eyeglasses or contact lenses. It is an essential part of an eye examination and is necessary to write a prescription for glasses and contact lenses.
- A refraction is NOT a covered service by Medicare, Medicaid or most insurance plans. These plans consider a refraction a “vision” service not a “medical” service
- We will NOT file the charge for a refraction with a health insurance plan unless we believe that your plan may cover the refraction charge.
- Our office fee for a refraction is \$70.00. However, if you pay at the time of service we will allow you a prompt pay discount of \$35.00 so your net cost would be \$35.00. The fee is in addition any copayment your plan may require. Should your plan pay use for the refraction we will reimburse you accordingly.
