HEALTH PLANS

To have your visit at WCC covered by insurance, patients must be assigned by their health plan.

If you have Medi-Cal coverage through HealthNet, Molina, LA Care, or Care 1st, please call us and we will provide you with our site code. This site code will be used by the health plan for assignment.

If you have private insurance coverage through HealthNet or LA Care, you can work directly with a representative at your chosen health plan for assignment to WCC.

WCC's primary care services help you maintain your great health:

In 1977, the WCC was created to treat a critical need for both child and women's healthcare services in the Wilmington area.

Over the years, the demand for care has only grown. The practice has grown as well, adding and expanding the number of patients which can be seen each year by practically 500%.

A majority of the WCC staff are from the community and have worked with the practice for more than five years, providing services to the families living in the surrounding areas from two locations.

The clinic also accepts most major forms of medical insurance.
