The providers at Gruene Lake Medical have provided doses of both Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen for infants and toddlers that are under the age of 2 years old. Please use this chart as a guide for you when your little one is teething or not feeling well. Reminder that Ibuprofen is not recommended for infants under the age of 6 months. If fever persists or is higher than 102 and your child is showing signs of illness, please contact our office to get an appt for your child.
