

From I-65 North:

Take the Church Street Exit. Turn right. Turn left on 21st Avenue and then left on Hayes Street. The parking garage entrance will be on your left. You may park in the garage or use the complimentary valet parking.

From I-65 South:


Take the Church Street Exit. Turn left onto Church Street. Turn left on 21st Avenue and then left on Hayes Street. The parking garage will be on the left. You may park in the garage or use the complimentary valet parking.

From West End Avenue:

Turn onto 20th Avenue (one way). Turn left onto Hayes Street. The parking garage and valet parking will be on your right. See below instructions for entering the Surgery Center.

Parking:

The 5th floor in the parking garage will allow easy access to the Surgery Center. Enter through the double doors and the Center is on the left. Valet parking is also available. If valet is used, enter the building on the 1st floor. In the lobby there is a set of elevators to the left for Plaza II. Take the elevators to the 4th floor. Turn left out of the elevator and then right at the end of the hallway. St. Thomas Surgery Center-Midtown is on the right.



Location and Parking for the Centennial Professional Plaza

From I-40 - Take I-40, Exit #209 at Charlotte Ave. Drive west on Charlotte (away from downtown), turn left onto 23rd Avenue North.

The Surgery Center, located at the Centennial Professional Plaza Building, will be on your right.

Parking - Parking is available in the parking garage located on 23rd Ave. North (across the street from Centennial Surgery Center).
