What to do: Before and After the Prolozone Procedure

BEFORE: A few days before having the treatment (for best results*):

- 1. AVOID the use of NSAIDS (ibuprofen, Motrin, Aleve, Naproxen, Aspirin, etc.) 3-5 days before procedure (Tylenol is OK for pain relief right up to and including the day of procedure do not exceed 4000mg in a 24 hour period).
- 2. AVOID the Systemic use of corticosteroids for 1 week before the procedure.
- 3. HYDRATE
- 4. OPTIONAL: Prepare to treat any bruising with Topical Arnica and/or Vitamin K cream to facilitate clearing.
 *Please note: Most patients get excellent results regardless.

DURING: The day of the procedure:

- 1. All paperwork will be completed
 - a. Personal Medical History
 - b. Symptom Questionnaires
 - c. Informed Consent Form
- 2. Prolozone solution is injected into the affected area followed by ozone.
- 3. CAUTION: Worsening of pain may follow injection and can last for a few hours or a few days. This a good sign! The healing affect continues for at least 7 days with each treatment.
- 4. Follow Up appointment is scheduled for 7-10 days after the procedure.

AFTER: The week(s) after the procedure (for best results):

- 1. CAUTION: Worsening of pain may follow injection and can last for several days. Although a "flare" does not always occur, when it does, it is considered a normal reaction. Please take Tylenol as directed and contact the office should the pain last for more than 48 hours.
- 2. AVOID the use of NSAIDS (ibuprofen, Motrin, Aleve, Naproxen, Aspirin, etc.) 3-7 days after procedure (Tylenol is OK for pain relief do not exceed 4000mg in a 24 hour period).
- 3. EAT a healthy diet and HYDRATE very well at least 64 ounces of clean fresh water.
- 4. Apply Ice to the procedure site for if feeling discomfort for 10 minutes.
- 5. AVOID touching, pressing and manipulating the injection site for at least 8 hours after the injection.
- 6. AVOID excessive activity that may aggravate the treated are for 2 weeks.

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
