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WOUND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

1. A pressure bandage has been applied to your wound. LEAVE THIS BANDAGE ON FOR A FULL 24 HOURS AND KEEP THE AREA DRY. *No shower until tomorrow.*
2. After 24 hours has passed (the day following your surgery), you may remove the bandage.
 - a) Cleanse the area with ½ hydrogen peroxide and ½ water.
 - b) Apply a thin layer of Polysporin ointment over the suture line.
 - c) Cut the telfa pad supplied to you to fit over the sutures.
 - d) Place band aid over the telfa pad.
3. Repeat the above instructions once a day until you return to the office for suture removal.
4. If you were given a prescription, make sure to fill it ASAP and finish taking the entire prescription.
5. Call the office at **(949) 640-0434** if you are experiencing a lot of pain, swelling, or bleeding. If the site is near your eye, some swelling and discoloration is common.
6. If your surgery site is on the face, it is recommended that you ice the area for the first 24 hours, applying for 10 minutes on then 20 minutes off until bedtime.
