

Instructions for TCA Chemical Peels

Before the peel

- 1. Discontinue Retin-A, Differin, Renova, Tazorac or Retinol 48 hours before the peel.
- 2. Avoid any glycolic acid creams or lotions for 24 hours before the peel.
- 3. If you have had a fever blister please notify the doctor or nurse prior to the peel. Chemical peels should not be applied if fever blisters or wounds are present or healing.
- 4. Take Ciprofloxacin twice a day, or Keflex 500mg four times a day to be started on day prior to the peel
- 5. Take Acyclovir 200mg five times a day or valtrex 500mg 2 times a day to be started one day prior to peel

After the peel

- 1. Use cetaphil soap to was the area twice a day
- 2. Soak face two times a day with a solution of 1 part water and 1 part clear vinegar. (will be started the day you start to peel)
- 3. Stay out of the sun. Sun exposure may cause dark blotchy spots on your skin.
- 4. Do not pick. Picking may cause permanent scarring.
- 5. Keep area moist all day with ointment such as pure Vaseline, Aquaphor healing ointment, or Polysporin.
- 6. If you have any questions about the healing process please don't hesitate to call our office.
- 7. No make-up until physician advises that it is ok.
- 8. Do not use any creams or lotion except what is recommended by the physician.
- 9. Do not restart your Retin-A, Differin, Renova, Tazorac or Retinol until physician advices you to do so.
