INFORMATION FOLLOWING VENEER TREATMENT

Following the first appointment for a Veneer(s), a small amount of tooth structure is removed on the front surface of your tooth. You may notice some temperature sensitivity, which will disappear once the veneer is bonded in place.

After the Veneer or Veneers are placed at the second visit you may have a sense that they are too large or just feel strange. This feeling will disappear after a short period of time. (Hours-Days only)

- * We will ask you to return a couple of days after Veneers are placed to remove excess cement and check on your fit and bite.
- * Although veneers are strong, we recommend always going a little easier on the veneers when biting into hard objects.
- * Proper brushing and flossing is necessary to help you retain this restoration
