



BLOOD THINNER/NON-STEROIDAL ANTI-INFLAMMATORY DRUGS (NSAIDS) LIST AND ANTI-INFLAMMATORY NON-USE AGREEMENT

Patients should stop all anti-inflammatories seven (7) days before their visit. If you are on a blood thinner, **DO NOT STOP** it. The doctor will assess and consult with you after he reviews your history. You will not be able to have an injection at this visit if you take a blood thinner.

Aggrenox (dipyridamole)	7 days
Coumadin/Warfarin	5 days
Jantoven	5 days
Lovenox	Off 24 hours before-12 hours after
Xarelto	5 days
Plavix (clopidrogel)	7 days
Pletal (cilostazol)	7 days
Perantine (dipyridamole)	7 days
Pradaxa (dabigatran etexilate)	3 days
Ticlid	14 days
Eliquis	Off 48 hours

Anti-inflammatories: These or any other form you may be taking-**STOP AT LEAST 7 DAYS PRIOR TO PROCEDURE**
