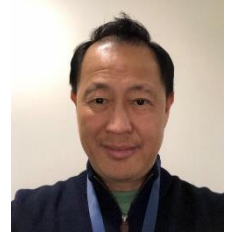
Medical Legal Evaluations

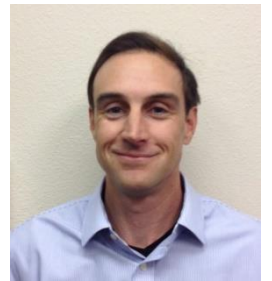
Physician Assistant
