Nurse Practitioner Position Responsibilities:

Perform new patient screenings, intakes, as well as physical exams for acute, chronic, and preventative care.

Update medical records to include medications, allergies, medical and surgical history, family and social history.

Utilizing electronic health record to maintain and update patient data as well as code patient contact appropriately in the medical record.

Order, administer and analyze laboratory testing.

Evaluate, diagnose, and prescribe for a wide variety of healthcare issues.

Strong knowledge of age-appropriate immunizations.

Detect changes in a patient's health and change treatment plans as necessary.

Administer medicines and treatments. Evaluate responses to treatments and medications.

Performs medical procedures according to experience and education and be willing to learn new techniques and/or procedures.

Consult with healthcare professionals and send referrals for secondary and tertiary care as appropriate.

Train patients and families on managing illnesses or injuries and disease prevention.

Assists Medical Director in developing clinical practice guidelines and developing/updating protocols.

Participates in medical care team meetings.

Performs all other duties as assigned.

Minimal of Master's degree or postmaster certificate as a family nurse practitioner from an accredited nursing program.

Must have RN and APRN licensure in the state of Nebraska and be board certified by either ANCC or AANP as a Family Nurse Practitioner.

Must have prescriptive authorization in Nebraska with valid DEA.

Current BLS.

Current ACLS certification or be willing to obtain ACLS.

Ability to communicate effectively, in verbal and written form, with retail and medical partners at various levels, patients, family members, providers and representatives of the community.

Sound understanding of federal and state regulations including HIPAA and OSHA.

Experience providing primary care as a family nurse practitioner for a minimum of 1 year.
