

RE: Dental care during pregnancy

To Whom It May Concern:

The above patient is being seen by me for her prenatal care. I have approved for her to see the dentist. X-rays are allowed only with proper pelvic shielding. Any procedures that are not urgent should wait until postpartum. However, fillings and extractions that are necessary can be done now. Lidocaine for local anesthetic is acceptable during pregnancy. Pain medication and antibiotics if needed can include Tylenol #3, Norco, Amoxicillin 500mg qid or Erythromycin 250mg qid if penicillin-allergic.
