Essential Functions

- Analyze and interpret patients' history, symptoms, physical findings, or diagnostic information to develop appropriate diagnoses.
- Develop treatment plans based on scientific rationale, standards of care, and professional practice guidelines.
- Diagnose or treat acute and/or chronic pain
- Prescribe medications based on efficacy, safety, and cost as legally authorized.
- Recommend interventions to modify behavior associated with health risks.
- Understand Electronic Health Record, utilize to its fullest capabilities, and have record complete within policy regulations.
