



Please take a moment to read about the following changes to our practice in light of COVID-19:



If you have traveled **ANYWHERE** outside of the state within the past 10 days, please do not come to the office unless you are able to provide a negative COVID test result. This includes ALL patients, including fully vaccinated and exempt individuals.*



If you feel sick, have a fever, cough, have been sick in the past 14 days, or have come into contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please call the office to reschedule your appointment.*



Please do not bring additional people to your appointment. Exceptions will be made for caregivers and legal guardians. Please have anyone who does not need to be at your appointment wait outside the office.



Please wear a mask to your appointment and be prepared to have your temperature checked on arrival. For your safety and the safety of our staff, we wear masks, practice social distancing as much as possible, disinfect rooms after each appointment, engage in frequent hand-washing, and regularly disinfect commonly touched surfaces.

*Telehealth appointments are offered in lieu of in-person visits if appropriate.
