

## **Exercise Stress Echo Patient Instructions**

During an Exercise Stress Echo Test, you will walk on a treadmill while your heart rate, blood pressure, and EKG are monitored. An echocardiogram/cardiac ultrasound is performed before and after the treadmill portion of the test. This entire test will take approximately one hour to complete.

To ensure the highest quality of the testing, all instructions must be followed. Failure to follow all instructions, <u>including arriving</u> <u>15 minutes prior to the test appointment time</u> may cause your appointment to be rescheduled.

## **Preparation for the Test**

- You may eat a light meal up to 2 hours prior to your test.
- Do not apply lotions, oils, or powders on the chest or stomach area on the morning of the exam.
- Wear comfortable, loose-fitting clothing. No one-piece garments or foundations (i.e., coveralls, dresses, slips, girdles, etc).
- Wear walking or athletic shoes *only*. Do not wear high heels, sandals, or flip flops.
- 24 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR TEST, DO NOT take drugs containing aminophylline or theophylline (ex: Theo-dur, Trental) unless your cardiologist states otherwise.
- 24 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR TEST, DO NOT take drugs that are beta blockers or calcium channel blockers unless your cardiologist states otherwise. If you are unsure if your medications fall into this category, please check with your pharmacist or call us to verify. A partial list follows:

- Bring a list of your current medications. We will need the name, dosage, and frequency of each medication. Also, if you are asthmatic, please bring your inhaler.
- Children and family members are not permitted in the room during the exam. Please arrange appropriate child care.
- Due to COVID-19 mask covering will be required during your test

Once your Cardiologist has reviewed your test results, the results of your test will be faxed to your Primary Care Physician. After the exam is completed, the Cardiologist will review the results with you.
