To ensure a successful exam, please follow all instructions carefully.

Remember, your procedure WILL be rescheduled if:

- ✓ You do not follow **ALL** prep instructions.
- ✓ You do not complete your **ENTIRE** preparation as instructed
- ✓ You do not have a ride home (it **MUST** be an adult friend or family member that **DRIVES** you)
- ✓ **If you take a TAXI or UBER you MUST have an adult friend or family member accompany you.**
- ✓ You are **NOT** able to take a Bus

❖ Your adult friend or family member that drops you off/ picks you up, MUST stay within a 30 minute distance of the procedure center.

☐ We are requesting clearance from your specialist. You are **NOT** to stop any medication without clearance. We will contact you with instructions of when to stop any medication

7 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE

STOP taking fish oil, vitamin E and any iron supplements.

STOP NSAIDs, Ibuprofen, Advil, Aleve, Motrin, Celebrex, Naproxen, Meloxicam

(If you take **Aspirin 81 mg**, you may continue to take this) **Tylenol is ok to take**

THE NIGHT BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE YOU SHOULD HAVE NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT

DIABETICS: Take your regular morning and daytime oral diabetic medications and insulin.
Only half of your long-acting insulin dose.

ON THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE

PLEASE DO NOT DRINK ANY WATER IN THE MORNING OF YOUR PROCEDURE , THIS CAN CAUSE A DELAY FOR YOUR PROCEDURE

DIABETICS: Check your glucose level in the morning of your procedure and **ONLY** if your diabetes is uncontrolled please take any oral diabetic medications or insulin

If your diabetes is controlled please **DO NOT** take your diabetes medications

You MAY take your morning medications as usual **WITH SMALL SIP OF WATER**
(which includes blood pressure, cholesterol, depression, anxiety, seizure
medication, thyroid medication, ETC.)
(DO NOT take NSAIDS or Blood thinners)

***Please bring your Inhaler and insulin with you**

***Avoid smoking 24 hours prior procedure and around the outside perimeters of the facility**

Please wear comfortable shoes- no heels
