Our first mission trip in 2019, we were able to successfully complete 8 surgeries. While COVID-19 restrictions proved to create hurdles for our organization, we continued to persevere and submitted over 100K in donations until we were able to physically return in 2022.

Foundation.




Sponsored Surgeons
