There are several medications that MUST NOT be taken prior to your procedure.

Medications that must be stopped for 7 DAYS prior to your scheduled procedure:

AGGRENOX (DIPYRIDANOLE) EXCEDRINE PLAVIX PRADAXA (DABIGATRAN)

Medications that must be stopped for 3 DAYS prior to your scheduled procedure:

ADVIL (IBUPROFEN) MOTRIN (IBUPROFEN) TRILISATE PIROXICAM
ALEVE (NAPROXEN) VICOPROFEN CELEBREX NABUMETONE
LODINE (ETODOLAC) NAPROSYN (NAPROXEN) VOLTARENTOLMETIN

MELOXICAM (MOBIC) DAYPRO (OXAPROZIN) DICLOFENAC INDOMETHACIN

Medications that must be stopped for 12 HOURS prior to your scheduled procedure:

HEPARIN LOVENOX

Diabetic Patients: If you are insulin only-Take 1/4 of your usual diabetic medications until AFTER your procedure. If you are diabetic, you may have small sips of juice without PULP to keep your blood sugar from dropping.

If you are scheduled before 1pm, please have nothing to eat/drink after midnight the night before your scheduled procedure. If you are scheduled after 1pm, please have nothing to eat/drink 8 hours prior to check in before your scheduled procedure. You may have SMALL sips of water if absolutely necessary, or if you need to take approved medications such as high blood pressure or prescription pain medications. If you take high blood pressure medications, please DO NOT skip any doses. Please be sure to let staff/anesthesia know of any/all medications you have taken when you check in for your scheduled procedure.

YOU MUST HAVE A DRIVER WITH YOU IF YOU ARE HAVING SEDATION/ ANESTHESIA FOR YOUR SCHEDULED PROCEDURE. THIS PERSON MUST HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE AND BE WILLING TO STAY WITH YOU FROM CHECK IN, UNTIL YOU ARE DISCHARGED FROM THE FACILITY. NO TAXI'S PERMITTED. Please make sure you have your insurance card, and a valid ID @ check in for procedure.

\*DRIVER MUST BE PRESENT FROM CHECK IN TIME THROUGH DISCHARGE TIME OR YOUR PROCEDURE WILL BE RESCHEDULED\*

- Please give 24 hour notice when cancelling a procedure.
- Please be aware that procedures can incur physician, anesthesia, and facility charges. Your insurance will be verified and the office will contact you to review estimated copays before your scheduled procedure
- You will also receive a phone call to confirm your check in time the day before your scheduled procedure. Sometimes schedules are adjusted last minute due to cancellations.
- All physician portion copays/ coinsurance payments must be collected prior to your procedure. We are unable to make any payment plans.
- If you insurance requires a prior authorization, and for any reason we are not able to obtain approval prior to your procedure, the office will contact you to reschedule to a later date.
