



Pocket KAMRA

What to Expect

Placement of the KAMRA Corneal Inlay involves the creation of a corneal pocket with a femtosecond laser. When unassociated with added vision sharpening laser treatments, recovery is the fastest and most straightforward of all the KAMRA procedures.

Week 1-

You can expect to see an almost immediate improvement in your unaided vision at near. Distance acuity may be blurry. It will require the healing of the KAMRA pocket in order to get the best quality of vision. This is because of the phenomenon of light scattering as it passes through which can be very common during the first several weeks after surgery. Your drops will include the steroid (Pred Forte) and your antibiotic (Zymaxid) each 4X a day along with frequent lubrication.

Week 2-

With good light your reading is getting better but things at both distance and near may still seem blurred or “filmy”. Healing needs to be encouraged by tapering the steroid drop to twice daily for one week.

Week 3-

The level of light scatter as measured by the AcuTarget continues to improve. With this reading becomes easier and your distance acuity is getting better each day. We will switch to a weaker steroid (FML) to be used 4x daily for two weeks and then tapering to 2X daily for an additional 2 weeks.

Weeks 8-12-

Taper to a maintenance level of the FML drop of once daily. Continue to lubricate and read with good light. You are on your way!
