The CAGE-AID is a brief questionnaire used to screen for alcohol/drug abuse and dependence in adults and adolescents over 16 years of age. The CAGE-AID is a screening tool designed to indicate whether a problem might exist. It is not intended to diagnose any illness or disease, nor is it a substitute for medical treatment.

| 3. Have you felt bad or guilty about your drinking or drug use? | Yes | No |
| 4. Have you ever had a drink or used drugs first thing in the morning to steady your nerves or to get rid of a hangover? | Yes | No |

An answer of "Yes" to 2 or more questions is considered clinically significant suggesting that further evaluation is recommended.
