Contact Lens Policy

A contact lens prescription requires an annual examination to determine that the eyes are healthy and suitable for contact lens wear, as well as to ensure that the lenses being fitted provide optimum vision and comfort.

A contact lens exam includes a prescription for glasses, a prescription for contacts, a trial pair of contacts, as well as a contact lens progress evaluation. Depending on the contact lens prescription or material, a trial pair of lenses will be dispensed to the patient at the initial visit. The patient is to wear the trial pair for the following 5 to 7 days upon which the patient will determine the overall success of the trial lenses, including satisfaction with the comfort and vision of the lenses. Should a problem occur with the lenses, it is the patient's responsibility to follow up with Galleria Vision Center in order to schedule a progress evaluation **within 30 days of the initial visit**, or the visit in which the contact lenses were initially dispensed. Following the 30 day period an additional fee of \$30 will be assessed for contact lens follow up visits. After 3 months, a new eye exam with the doctor is required at regular charge.
