## LEEP PROCEDURE

- 1. Pelvic rest for three (3) weeks.
- 2. You may experience some bleeding following the therapy. This may not start for a few days, and may last as long as two (2) weeks. The bleeding may be anything from light spotting to a flow as heavy as an average menstrual period. If the bleeding persists after two weeks or if it so heavy that you must change a maxi pad every two hours or more, please call the office.
- 3. You should avoid any type of exercise for three (3) weeks to reduce the chance of bleeding.
- 4. Make an appointment to be seen in the office in one (1) week.
- 5. You may have some cramping for a few days. Take Ibuprofen or Aleve as directed. If this does not help, call the office.

## <u>CALL THE OFFICE IF YOU EXPERIENCE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:</u>

- o Fever of 100 degrees or more
- o A new or constant pain in pelvic area
- o Persistent nausea or vomiting
- o Bleeding, as described above
