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Post Operative Instructions for Dilation and Curettage

- 1. Expect vaginal flow from 3-12 days. The flow should be lighter than a period after the first day.
- 2. Refrain from physical exercise for the first week after surgery, as this can cause increased bleeding.
- 3. You may have muscular aches and pains the day following surgery, due to the muscle relaxant that may be used during anesthesia.
- 4. Report to Dr. Ahdoot any heavy vaginal bleeding, passage of clots, severe pain or a temperature of 100 degrees or more.
- 5. Showering is OK the day of surgery.
- 6. You may use a heating pad for abdominal discomfort.
- 7. Refrain from douching, tampon use, tub baths or intercourse until seen in the office.
- 8. Please call Dr. Ahdoot's office to schedule your follow-up appointment for 1 week.
