LAXATIVE BOWEL PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS.

Colonoscopy Date:	

For this Preparation, you will need:

- 1. One 238-gram bottle of Miralax (over the counter)
- 2. One bottle of Magnesium Citrate (over the counter)

These Instructions are for the day prior to your colonoscopy or surgery.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO DRINK ONLY CLEAR LIQUIDS THE ENTIRE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE. DO NOT EAT ANY SOLID FOODS AND DO NOT DRINK ANYTHING THAT IS <u>COLORED RED</u>.

"CLEAR LIQUIDS" INCLUDE:

- Water
- Ice Tea
- Lemonade, Apple, or White Grape Juice (No Pulp)
- Clear Broth or Bouillon
- Decaffeinated Coffee or Tea (no milk or Non dairy Creamer)
- Gatorade or other sports drinks (not red or blue)
- Kool-Aid or other flavored drinks(not red or blue)
- Plain Jell-o or other gelatins with no toppings or fruit added (not red or blue)
- Popsicles (not red or blue)

START PREP:

5:00 pm:

- 1. Mix one 238-gram bottle of Miralax into 64-ounces of Gatorade, Juice, or Water.
- 2. Shake the solution until the Miralax has dissolved.
- 3. **Drink** eight-ounces every 10-15 minutes until the entire solution is gone.

7:00pm:

Drink 10 fluid ounces of Magnesium Citrate. (To improve the taste, chill it ahead of time.)

Immediately after drinking Magnesium Citrate, drink 2 to 3 eight ounces of clear liquids.

Continue to drink clear liquids until bedtime.

NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE:

You may take your Blood Pressure and Heart medication, with a small sip of water. With a doctor's permission, discontinue Coumadin 3 days prior to your procedure.

With a doctor's permission discontinue Aspirin and Plavix 7 days prior to your procedure.

Someone must accompany you home from the office. You cannot drive until the next Morning. Any problems with the prep please call office or service at (516) 674-5862. You must notify the office 48 hours prior if you intend to cancel or reschedule your procedure. Otherwise, you will be subject to a charge.
