What are the symptoms of Venous reflux disease?

Symptoms include aching, swelling, cramping, heaviness, tiredness of the legs. As the disease progresses, it can lead to skin color changes, varicose veins, and open skin ulcers.

What causes Venous reflux disease?

Many factors including age, female gender, family history, lifting heavy objects, pregnancies, and jobs that require prolonged standing can contribute to the disease.

Can the venous disease be prevented?

For mild disease, lifestyle changes like regular exercise, and reducing excess weight may help. We advise leg elevation, medical grade compression stockings and avoidance of prolonged standing to manage the symptoms.

How would you know if I need treatment?

We use Doppler ultrasound scan to find out if you have vein disease. Varicose veins is not just a cosmetic problem as symptoms get worse over time.

What treatments can help me?

We perform minimally invasive Radiofrequency ablation- a procedure through which a small catheter is used to deliver controlled heat to collapse the damaged veins which gradually disappear. This procedure is proven to cause less pain and bruising than laser ablation.

What treatment options are available for Spider veins?

Spider veins are squiggly, red and discolored purple veins on the surface of the skin. We inject a small dose of a sclerosant solution into the veins which disappear and give you back healthy-looking legs.

How long does the procedure last?

The procedure typically lasts from 15-30 minutes.

How soon can I go home?

You should be able to go home shortly after the procedure as it's performed under local anesthesia.

Is it painful?

You may experience discomfort for a short period of time at the procedure site.
